Jan/Feb 1863. KIA 2 May 1863 at Chancellorsville, VA.

GARRIS, Alexander, PVT Resided in ~~the~~ ^{N.H. City} ENL: 11 Jun 1861
for the war at age 22, Wounded in action 1 July 1861.
Malvern Hill, VA. & died in hospital ^(Richmond) 3 Aug 1862 of wounds.

GARRIS, Patrick H. PVT Resided in N.H. City ENL: 12 Jun 1861

for the war at age 20. KIA Malvern Hill, VA. 1 July 1862

CO "A" 51st Infantry Reg't NC Troops. George W Garriss, PVT

ENL: in New Haven City 14 July 1862 for the war. Present or accounted for until
captured at ~~the~~ ^{the} Harbor, VA 1 June 1864, confined at Pt. Lookout, MD,

transferred to Elmira, NY 12 July 1864, paroled at Elmira, & transferred
to James River, VA. on or about 20 Feb 1865 for exchange, hospitalized

at Richmond, VA about 10 March 1865, with an unspecified complaint.

Furloughed 22 March 1865 for 60 days.

PRESENT OR ACCOUNTED FOR UNTIL CAPTURED & PAROLED AT
PARIS, VA 5 NOV 1862 - ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL AT RICHMOND, VA

ON 26 NOV 1862 WITH "CONTUSIO FOOT" RETURNED TO DUTY

JAN/FEB 1863. KIA 2 MAY 1863 AT CHANCELLORSVILLE, VA.

GARRIS, ALEXANDER, PVT RESIDED IN ~~N.H. CITY~~ ENCL: 11 JUN 1861

FOR THE WAR AT AGE 22, WOUNDED IN ACTION 1 JULY 1861.

MALVERN HILL, VA. & DIED IN HOSPITAL 3 AUG 1862 OF WOUNDS.

GARRIS, PATRICK H. PVT RESIDED IN N.H. CITY ENCL: 12 JUN 1861

FOR THE WAR AT AGE 20 - KIA MALVERN HILL, VA. 1 JULY 1862.
